School Goals

No FSA scores from last year

We have STAR scores from our last STAR test for the previous school year. Students at proficiency are as followed:

6 th Grade –	35% in Reading
	51% in Math
7 th Grade -	29% in Reading
	56% in Math
8 th Grade –	28% in Reading
	24% in Math

Most funds will be concentrated on funding Reading efforts but will be discussed once the budget information has been shared with school.

E-Learning

Holt spoke with teachers and the first few weeks involved a lot of parent calls about students not logging in. The last two weeks have seen an improvement. Of the parent calls 99% of the parents have been understanding and patient.

Yearbook

Blackman asked King about this year's yearbook. Ms. King expressed dissatisfaction with the yearbook distributor last year and said she did not think the yearbook club was a possibility to create the yearbook. In conclusion, no yearbook this year.

Hoodies

Blackman asked if the school was going to abide by the rules of only a SHMS jacket for this year. Selph felt that given the financial restrictions that have happened due to COVID, he is not comfortable mandating this rule at this time.

Fundraisers

Will we have fundraisers? Selph felt it was not wise at this time due to financial restrictions due to COVID. He does not feel as though the district would support any fundraising.
